The authority, however, reserves the right to increase the number of short-listed pre-qualified applicants (“bidders”) by adding an additional applicant. The authority expects to short list up-to <b>7(Seven)</b> pre-qualified applicants for participation in the bid stage. The authority, however, reserves the right to increase the number of short-listed pre-qualified applicants (“bidders”) by adding an additional applicant.
2.	3.5.3	NIL	The authority may, in its discretion, maintain a reserve list of pre-qualified applicants who may be invited to substitute the short listed applicants in the event of their withdrawal from the bid process or upon their failure to confirm to the conditions specified herein; provided that a substitute applicant shall be given at least 30(thirty) days to submit its bid.
